

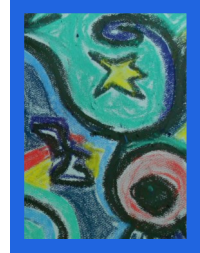
Paul Klee Chalk Pastel Project - The Night Sky

We completed this project following a trip to the local observatory but you could spend a few minutes outside after dark viewing the stars and the moon.

Additional Preparation:

Materials: Chalk pastels, pastel paper, black oil pastel, paper towels for clean up.



Use your imagination and have fun making your own Klee style artwork with pastels.

On your paper, draw the following elements with a black oil pastel:

- ◆ Moon, star, meteor, or constellation.
- ◆ A stick figure
- ◆ The letters V and C
- ◆ Three dots
- ◆ Two random lines – one needs to be touching the side of your paper
- ◆ Square
- ◆ A swirl
- ◆ One other element of your choosing – face, circle, etc



Now choose a color palette to fit the mood of your artwork. Use 4-6 chalk pastels of your choice and fill in the background of your artwork. Remember how Klee used color blocks and areas of color in his work. Fill the complete page with color.

Go back over your black lines if needed.
